

What's new in Hong Kong?

The Hong Kong Observation Wheel showcasing stunning daytime and night time views of the spectacular Hong Kong harbour has been opened for public. It has 42 luxury eight-seat gondolas (including one special VIP gondola) that are all equipped with high-tech safety and super-fast HKT wi-fi communication systems.

The 60-metre observation wheel will get an estimated one million passengers a year, offering both night and day panoramic views. Visitors will be able to ride the wheel between 11am to 11pm for the 15 to 20 minute journey

at the cost of HK\$100 (\$12.8) for adults.

In other news, UAE's national carrier Etihad Airways and Hong Kong Airlines have signed a codeshare agreement to provide travellers with enhanced connections between Asia, the Middle East and Europe. Subject to regulatory approval, Hong Kong Airlines' 'HX' code will be placed on Etihad Airways' triple-daily flights between Abu Dhabi and Bangkok, together with two upcoming services that will connect Abu Dhabi to Madrid from March 29 and to Hong Kong from June 15 this year.
